4. Bells in the cold tower, 'midst the snow of win - ter sound out the spring song

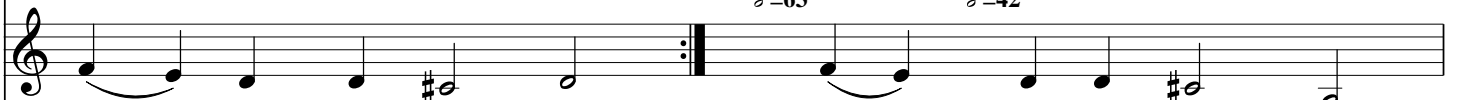

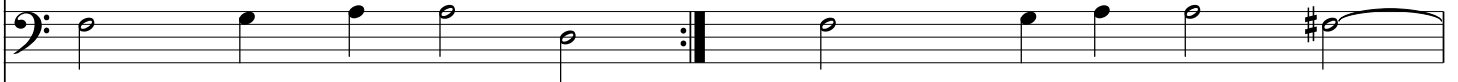

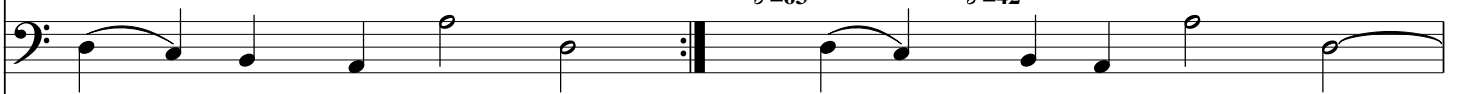
